
Indiana State Plane Projection, West
Contour Interval: 5 Feet












JCC_waterbodies + tree canopy + slopes over 15%




JCC_waterbodies + tree canopy + slopes over 10%

7 GUIDING OBSERVATIONS

1. Site has **visual and environmental** properties unique in the Jasper Park system. Reuse plan should take full advantage of these attributes.
2. Site's **topography and access** limits new structures and active development to relatively small area of the overall site.
3. **Water bodies** are strong amenity and focal point of site; consider expansion or aggregation into one large lake
4. Significant **grading and tree canopy** clearing should be minimized

7 GUIDING OBSERVATIONS

5. **Active recreational** uses can be more appropriately accommodated off-site (south of 15th Street)
6. Potential physical community “center” can best be accommodated at **southwest corner** adjacent to 15th Street.
7. Site more amenable to development of **outdoor community programming** related to arts, environmental education, fitness, health, and ecology.



PROGRAM IDEAS - Educational and passive recreation

POTENTIAL PROGRAMS

- Nature trails, bike paths
- “Managed meadows”
- Community Arts and Environmental programs (outdoor)
- Expansion of Lakes: fishing, lakeside paths and seating areas, small picnic areas
- Safe pedestrian connection across 15th Street
- Primary access and parking from 15th Street. Additional access desirable from Newton Road and Scheutter Road.
- “Community Center” (program-related)








New Elementary School Concept Plan

Build New ES up to 750 Student Capacity





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
