

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE  
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF JASPER  
NOVEMBER 26, 2013**

The Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Jasper, Indiana, met in special session on Tuesday, November 26, 2013, in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 610 Main Street.

**CALL TO ORDER**

Presiding Officer Mayor Terry Seitz called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m. The meeting was advertised for 9:00 a.m. but due to the length of a prior meeting, was called to order as soon thereafter.
