

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
STORM WATER MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE CITY OF JASPER
April 9, 2012**

The Storm Water Management Board of the City of Jasper, Indiana, met in regular session on Monday, April 9, 2012 in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 610 Main Street.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Raymond Eckerle, who presided, called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

ROLL CALL

Also present were City Engineer Chad Hurm and Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy.

Chairman Raymie Eckerle announced that a majority of the board members must be present for a quorum. All three of the board members were present; therefore, there was a quorum for the meeting.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairman Eckerle led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

The Board members examined the minutes of the regular meeting that was held on March 12, 2012. Chairman Eckerle **motioned** and Vice Chairman Messmer seconded to approve the minutes as presented. **Motion** carried 3-0.

CLAIMS

Chairman Eckerle presented claims in the amount of \$173,223.31 from March 9, 2012, through April 5, 2012. Secretary Seger **motioned** to approve the claims as presented. Vice Chairman Messmer seconded. **Motion** passed 3-0.

STORM WATER DEPARTMENT REPORTS by City Engineer

Review of Claims City Engineer Chad Hurm reviewed the claims from March 9, 2012, to April 5, 2012.

Project Report, Badendorff Project City Engineer Chad Hurm stated that the contractor has started re-grading and cleaning up. Chad Hurm also stated that the filling of the old storm sewer is scheduled for Wednesday, April 11, 2012. After the old pipe is filled, the concrete work will begin.

Skyline Subdivision Sanitary Sewer Project City Engineer Chad Hurm stated that Skyline Subdivision Sanitary Sewer Project has started. Chad Hurm stated that the Storm Water Department will keep a watch over the project for storm water purposes.

Project Report, Beaver Lake Project City Engineer Chad Hurm stated that the project is moving along and at the beginning of May they are hoping to let the lake fill back up.

STORM WATER DEPARTMENT REPORTS by Storm Water Coordinator

ERU Update Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy presented to the Board a copy of the March 2012 Building Permits, with 2 additional ERUs indicated on the list. Chad Mundy also stated that Buffalo Flat is far enough along to calculate their ERUs. The ERUs were calculated at 25 ERUs. Chairman Eckerle **motioned** to approve the list as presented; with 2 new ERUs and 25 ERUs for Buffalo Flat. Vice Chairman Messmer seconded the motion. **Motion** passed 3-0.

ERU Calculations for Brookstone Estates III Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated he has started the calculations for Brookstone Estates III and will have more to report next meeting.

Drainage Permits Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated there was one new drainage permit since last month's Storm Water Board meeting. Chad Mundy also stated that there are a total of eight open drainage permits and that open permits are reviewed every month.

IDEM Monthly Report Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that the monthly IDEM report has been completed and filed. The report listed seventeen sites that were inspected in the month of March. There were also four rain inspection on March 2nd, 8th, 15th, & 30th, 2012, of all Rule 5 construction sites.

Construction Site Violations Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that there was one violation since last month's meeting. This violation was for the Jeff & Angie Smith house. Chad Mundy stated that there was a silt fence down that was protecting a curb inlet. Chad Mundy presented to the board a picture of sediment over topping a silt fence lying on the ground.

Erosion Control Permits Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated there was one new permit issued. The permit was issued for the renewal of Windsong Estates. Chad Mundy also stated that there were no new plans submitted since last month's Storm Water Board meeting.

Illicit Discharge Updates Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that there were three new illicit discharges to report.

- 1) A white liquid material was found in a storm sewer box on Cherry Street, between Kimbal and Inwood. Chad Mundy stated that neither manufacturer could identify the material. Jasper Waste Water was contacted and given a sample of the water to test. The next day Jasper Waste Water cleaned the storm sewer box and accepted the water into the Waste Water Plant.
- 2) A pile of white granular material was discovered by the Jasper Street Department on top of and in a storm sewer box on the corner of 14th & Altmeyer Road. Chad Mundy stated the source of the material wasn't found. The Jasper Street Department used the vac truck and cleaned the storm sewer box.
- 3) At 2060 Lube Way Road, Ackerman Oil had a fire up against one of their buildings, under an awning. The Jasper Fire Department put out the fire. The water from the Jasper Fire Department and the sprinklers caused contaminated water to enter the waste water system. Further down the system was a lift station that was overflowing with contaminated water. This water lead to an unnamed creek around 200 yards north of the fire. Andy Stinchfield from IDEM was contacted and led the cleanup effort. The Jasper Fire Department, Jasper Waste Water Department, Jasper Street Department, Jasper Storm Water Department and employees from Ackerman Oil also helped with the cleanup effort.

Open House BMPs, Erosion Control for Clean Water Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated the Open House was March 20, 2012 at the Jasper Train Depot. The following organizations hosted the Open House:

- 1) Utility Supply Company
- 2) Dubois County Soil & Water Conservation District
- 3) Erosion Resources & Supply
- 4) Advanced Drainage Systems, Inc.
- 5) Southern Indiana Supply
- 6) City of Jasper Stormwater Department

Technical presentations were given by Chad Mundy & Amanda Bough. Chad Mundy stated the open house went well, but could have had more attendants.

2012 Herald Ads Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy presented to the board five new ads that will be running in the Herald in 2012. Chad Mundy stated that these ads will be used when neither Dubois County Soil & Water Conservation District nor the Jasper Storm Water Department has a current message for the paper.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the board, a **motion** was made by Chairman Eckerle, seconded by Vice Chairman Messmer and carried 3-0 to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 10:32 a.m.
