

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
STORM WATER MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE CITY OF JASPER
February 13, 2012**

The Storm Water Management Board of the City of Jasper, Indiana, met in regular session on Monday, February 13, 2012 in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 610 Main Street.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Raymond Eckerle, who presided, called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

ROLL CALL

Chairman Raymond Eckerle	present
Vice Chairman Roger Messmer	present
Secretary David Seger	absent

Also present were City Engineer Chad Hurm and Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy.

Chairman Raymie Eckerle announced that a majority of the board members must be present for a quorum. Two of the three board members were present; therefore, there was a quorum for the meeting.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairman Eckerle led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

The Board members examined the minutes of the regular meeting that was held on January 9, 2012. Chairman Eckerle **motioned** and Vice Chairman Messmer seconded to approve the minutes as presented. **Motion** carried 2-0.

CLAIMS

Chairman Eckerle presented claims in the amount of \$750.65 from January 6, 2012, through February 9, 2012. Vice Chairman Messmer **motioned** to approve the claims as presented. Chairmen Eckerle seconded. **Motion** passed 2-0.

STORM WATER DEPARTMENT REPORTS by City Engineer

Review of Claims City Engineer Chad Hurm reviewed the claims from January 6, 2012, to February 9, 2012.

Project Report, Badendorff Project City Engineer Chad Hurm stated that the contractor has 150 feet of pipe to lay and one storm water box to install, before they can back fill. There was conversation on the importants of filling the old pipe that will remain in the ground.

LTAP Conference City Engineer Chad Hurm stated that he, along with Chad Mundy and Raymie Eckerle, went to the Stormwater Drainage Conference in West Lafayette. The conference was February 9, 2012. Chad Hurm also stated that it was an informative conference and covered many subjects of Storm water.

STORM WATER DEPARTMENT REPORTS by Storm Water Coordinator

ERU Update Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy presented to the Board a copy of the January 2012 Building Permits, with 1 additional ERUs indicated on the list. Vice Chairman Messmer **motioned** to approve the list as presented; with 1 new ERU. Chairman Eckerle seconded the motion. **Motion** passed 2-0.

Drainage Permits Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated there were two new drainage permits since last month's Storm Water Board meeting. Chad Mundy also stated that there are a total of eight open drainage permits and that open permits are reviewed every month.

IDEM Monthly Report Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that the monthly IDEM report has been completed and filed. The report listed sixteen sites that were inspected in the month of December. There were also three rain inspections on January 11, 17, and 23, 2012, of all Rule 5 construction sites.

Construction Site Violations Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that there was one violation since last month's meeting. This violation was for the VUJC site for sediment leaving the site.

Erosion Control Permits Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated there was one new erosion control permit issued for the Indiana Furniture Industries addition project. Chad Mundy also stated that there were no new plans submitted since last month's Storm Water Board meeting.

Illicit Discharge Updates Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that there was one new illicit discharge to report. The E&K Electric building at 306 Twenty-Fifth Street has several illicit taps. There are many floor drains that feed into the storm sewer system. A follow up inspection will be completed after the corrections are made.

Storm Water Educational Ads in the Herald Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated the storm water department would like to use a program the Herald has offered. The program offers a 2" x 3" spot in every Wednesday paper and offers a colored 2" x 3" spot in the "TV in the Herald" every Saturday. Chad Mundy also stated that the Jasper Storm Water Department would partner with Dubois County Soil & Water Conservation District and share the cost of this program. The total cost of this program is \$2,854. The Jasper Storm Water Department would pay \$1427.40 and Dubois County Soil & Water Conservation District would pay \$1427.40 for the cost of the program. Chairman Eckerle **motioned** to approve the expense of \$1,427.40 for advertising twice weekly for the Jasper Herald. Vice Chairman Messmer seconded the motion. **Motion** passed 2-0.

Facebook Update Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that the educational Facebook page is up to 53 "likes." This means that 53 people will receive educational messages that are posted on Facebook.

Inlet Filter Program Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that he has a signed contract from Todd Kerstiens for 3 inlet filters and a signed contract from Terry Streicher for 7 inlet filters. These contracts are for 6 months. Chad Mundy also stated that he and the inspection crew removed the 7 units from Cambridge Estates I. The inspection crew cleaned the units and then installed them at West View Estates II.

2012 Erosion Control Seminar Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated on February 7, 2012 he attended the 2012 Erosion Control Seminar. Chad Mundy also stated that it was an informative seminar and gave him a chance to talk to Karen Barnhill, the City of Evansville Storm Water Coordinator.

Open House BMPs, Erosion Control for Clean Water Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated on March 20, 2012, the Jasper Storm Water Department and Dubois County Soil & Water Conservation District will host an educational open house at the Jasper Train Depot. Chad Mundy also stated that the open house will have guest speakers from 11:00am to 12:00pm.

Badendorff Inspection Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated Chad Hurm and he completed a storm water inspection of the Badendorff project.

VUJC project Storm Water Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that he was asked to be on a steering committee for the VUJC project. The first meeting was February 10th at VUJC. Chad Mundy asked Judi Brown to inform the Storm Water Board on this project.

Judi Brown, Dubois County Soil & Water Conservation District Judi Brown stated that this is a new program working with VUJC, using their farm land, with conservational practices. No till, cover crops and other conservational practices will be used and the results will be researched. The farm land consists of 50 to 60 acres directly behind the campus.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the board, a **motion** was made by Chairman Eckerle, seconded by Vice Chairman Messmer and carried 2-0 to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 10:42 a.m.
