

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY OF JASPER PARK  
AND RECREATION BOARD, JASPER, INDIANA HELD AT 4:30 P.M.,  
JANUARY 8, 2008**

The Regular Meeting of the Jasper Park and Recreation Board was called to order at 4:30 P.M. by President Zoglman.

President Zoglman led the board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Secretary Vogler conducted roll call:

Member Seger nominated the same slate of officers for the 2008 Park Board: Ed Zoglman, President; Dan Wehr, Vice-President and Bernie Vogler, Secretary. No other nominations were made. Member Berger made a motion to close nominations and it was seconded by Vice-President Wehr. All were in favor, 5 – 0. The above nominations were approved 5 – 0.

The minutes from the Regular December meeting were approved on a motion by Vice-President Wehr and seconded by Member Seger. All were in favor, 5 - 0.

The monthly claims were approved on a motion by Member Berger and seconded by Secretary Vogler. All were in favor, 5 – 0.

Mary Ann Smith, director of the Older Americans, presented her monthly report from the center. She told the board that 2 buses were taken to Derby Dinner Theater, the Singing Seniors went caroling to the local nursing homes and 170 seniors attended the annual Christmas Party. The Ride Solutions program started January 2, and on Friday there were 4 vans in Jasper. The first week was very successful.

Director of Golf, Steve Milligan, gave the financial reports for both golf courses. The Jasper Municipal Golf Course revenue for December was \$9,377.43 compared to last year which was \$13,763.55, for a decrease of \$4,386.12. For the year 2007 revenue was \$394,299.33 compared to 2006 which was \$411,440.10 for a decrease of \$17,140.77. Revenue at the Ruxer Golf Course for December was \$355.00 compared to last year which was \$1,605.18, for a decrease of \$1,250.18. For the year 2007 revenue was \$159,350.08 compared to 2006 which was \$141,835.00 for an increase of \$17,515.08. Director of Golf Milligan informed the board of the various activities and special events that will take place at the golf courses in the coming year.

The Mayor's approval for the Park Director, Ken Buck was approved on a motion by Secretary Vogler and seconded by Vice-President Wehr. All were in favor, 5 – 0. The Mayor's approval for the Assistant Park Director, Mike Oeding was approved on a

motion by Member Berger and seconded by Member Seger. All were in favor, 5 – 0.

Assistant Director Oeding presented the board with proposed fees for 2008 at the Jasper Municipal Swimming Pool. The fees have not been raised for five years.

Vice-President Wehr made a motion for Attorney Hemmerlein to prepare a resolution to be presented to the City Council to accept these proposed fees. The motion was seconded by Member Berger. All were in favor, 5 – 0.

Director Buck presented the board proposed fee changes for Kamp 4 Kids. The present weekly fee is \$25.00 and the proposed fee for 2008 would raise to \$30.00. The fee hasn't been raised for 5 years. Member Seger made a motion for Attorney Hemmerlein to prepare a resolution to be presented to the City Council to accept the proposed fee change. The motion was seconded by Member Berger. All were in favor, 5 – 0.

Recreation Director Lesko presented the board with the financial reports from Girls' Slow Pitch Softball, Girls' Fast-Pitch Softball, Jasper Youth Baseball Concession Stand and Jasper Youth Baseball. Recreation Director Lesko suggested the contracts stay the same as last year. The board approved the contract with Girls' Slow Pitch Softball for \$7,000.00, Girls' Fast-Pitch Softball for \$2,000.00, and Jasper Youth Baseball for \$7,000.00, on a motion by Vice-President Wehr and seconded by Member Berger. All were in favor, 5 – 0.

Assistant Director Oeding informed the board that quotes will be presented at next month's meeting for a mowing unit at Ruxer Golf Course, 2 mowing units for the park maintenance department and fertilizer quotes for the sports complex. Quotes for chain link fencing for the Municipal Golf Course will also be presented.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 5:20 p.m., on a motion by Secretary Vogler and seconded by Member Berger. All were in favor, 5 – 0.
