

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY OF JASPER PARK
AND RECREATION BOARD, JASPER, INDIANA HELD AT 4:30 P.M.,
OCTOBER 9, 2007**

The Regular Meeting of the Jasper Park and Recreation Board was called to order at 4:30 P.M. by President Zoglman.

President Zoglman led the board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the Regular September meeting were approved on a motion by Vice-President Wehr and seconded by Secretary Vogler. All were in favor, 4 – 0.

The monthly claims were approved on a motion by Member Seger and seconded by Secretary Vogler. All were in favor, 4 – 0.

Director Buck gave the financial report. The Municipal Golf Course revenues were up approximately \$5,900.00 for September compared to last year and Ruxer Golf Course was up approximately \$7,800.00. Counting both courses, we are up approximately \$1,600.00.

Bev Hinkle, assistant director of the Older Americans, presented the board with her monthly report. 91 seniors were at bingo today. A trip to French Lick Casino is planned for next month.

Assistant Director Oeding up-dated the board on the fall projects. The lighting at the Junior Football field is almost completed. All the fields at the sports complex have been aerated and seeded. The work on the Municipal Golf Course pro-shop is scheduled to start on Monday. The paving of the parking lot at the Schroeder Sports Complex is scheduled to begin next week. Work has been started on installing the new liner for the wading pool. The carpet will be installed this spring.

Director Buck told the board that it’s time to start planning for the shelter house/restrooms at the Jasper Youth Sports Complex. Vice-President Wehr and Member Seger volunteered to help assist staff with this project.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 5:00 p.m., on a motion by Member Seger and seconded by Vice-President Wehr. All were in favor, 4 – 0.
