# INDIVIDUAL TICKETS NOW AVAILABLE FOR JASPER COMMUNITY ARTS' 2019-2020 PERFORMING ARTS SEASON

JASPER, IN... Individual tickets are now on sale for Jasper Community Arts' 2019-2020 season. Twelve performances will be showcased across four series. JCA's 2019-2020 season will run from September 2019 through March 2020.

Single tickets for all performances will be sold up to the show date or until the performance is sold out. Patrons do not need to buy an entire series to order tickets, but JCA does recommend that you purchase your tickets in advance due to demand. Single tickets are filled on a first come, first served basis, so interested patrons should order single tickets as soon as possible. All ticket sales are final.

Patrons interested in purchasing series tickets may still do so, but should contact the box office as soon as possible. Orders are filled on a first come, first served basis.
