Call to Order. President Pro Tempore Kevin Manley called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Purpose. The purpose of the special meeting was to conduct a public hearing and consider an additional appropriation ordinance.

PUBLIC HEARING-ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS

President Pro Tempore Kevin Manley opened the public hearing concerning proposed additional appropriations for the year 2019 that are listed in Ordinance No. 2019-30. A notice to taxpayers appeared in the Herald on September 20, 2019.

Manley asked for comments from the public. No comments were received. Thereafter, a motion was made by Council member Nancy Eckerle and seconded by Council member David Hurst to close the public hearing. Motion carried 5-0 and the public hearing was closed.

Ordinance No. 2019-30 was then presented.

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-30 "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEY FOR THE CITY OF JASPER, INDIANA, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019"

This ordinance transfers \$1.2 million from the Rainy Day Fund to the EDIT Fund, removes \$1.2 million appropriation in the Rainy Day Fund, and appropriates \$1.4 million from the EDIT Fund for the re-allocation of the River Centre projects.

A motion was made by Council member Nancy Eckerle and seconded by Council member David Hurst to consider the ordinance for one reading only. Motion carried 5-0. Thereafter, a motion was made by Council member Nancy Eckerle and seconded by Council member John Schroeder to read the ordinance in full. Motion carried 5-0. City Attorney Renee Kabrick then read the ordinance in full. Thereafter, a motion was made by Council member John Schroeder and seconded the ordinance in full.

by Council member Philip Mundy to pass and adopt Ordinance No. 2019-30. Motion carried 5-0.

Adjournment. There being no further business to come before the board, a motion was made by Council member David Hurst and seconded by Council member John Schroeder to adjourn the special meeting. The motion carried 5-0 and the meeting adjourned at 8:07 a.m.
