APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

NEW BUSINESS

<u>Subdivision Plat – Major – Seger Family Farm Addition</u>

Brad Eckerle, Brosmer Land Surveying and Engineering was present on behalf of Scott and Rebecca Seger to present a two-lot subdivision on the East side of Jasper at Meridian Road and State Road 164. Mr. Eckerle reported that in addition to primary approval of the proposed two lot subdivision, approval is also required to allow an access easement for a two-lot, single family, residential subdivision without frontage, in an R1 Zone. Mr. Eckerle noted the two proposed tracts are driven by topography with the North lot being 4.1 acres and the South being 6.7 acres.

Mr. Eckerle reported that per the requirement of utility extension, water is being treated as a water main and Dubois Water will go to the highway. Dubois water would be the provider. Soil testing is scheduled to determine the septic site. Gas would be provided by City of Jasper and electricity would be provided by Dubois REC.

President Lorey opened the public hearing. As no remonstrators were present, Greg Schnarr made a motion to close the public hearing. Ann Shappard seconded it. Motion carried 9-0. After further discussion, Greg Schnarr made a motion to approve the request allowing the access easement without frontage. Blake Krueger seconded it. Motion carried 9-0. Glen Pierce then made a motion to approve the two-lot subdivision. Dana Schnarr seconded it. Motion carried 9-0.

With no further business at hand, Chad Hurm made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Ann Shappard. The motion carried 9-0, and the meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m.
