MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE CITY OF JASPER April 8, 2024

The Stormwater Management Board of the City of Jasper, Indiana, met in regular session on April 8, 2024, in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 610 Main Street.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Roger Messmer, who presided, called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Chairman Roger Messmer announced that a majority of the board members must be present for a quorum. Two of the three members were present; therefore, there was a quorum for the meeting.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

The Board members examined the minutes of the regular meeting that was held on March 11, 2024. Secretary Greg Kuntz **motioned** to approve the minutes as presented. Chairman Roger Messmer seconded. **Motion** passed 2-0.

CLAIMS

City Engineer Chad Hurm presented claims in the amounts of \$8,974.46 from March 8, 2024, through April 4, 2024. Secretary Greg Kuntz made a **motion** to approve the claims as presented. Chairman Roger Messmer seconded. **Motion** passed 2-0.

STORMWATER DEPARTMENT REPORTS by City Engineer Chad Hurm

Main Street Phase II: City Engineer Chad Hurm stated that on April 9, 2024, they have a bid opening at the Board Public Works & Safety meeting, and he will keep the board updated. He is also having survey work done for Rees Street and Brescher Street.

STORM WATER DEPARTMENT REPORTS by Stormwater Coordinator Chad Mundy

ERU Update: Stormwater Coordinator Chad Mundy presented to the Board a copy of the March 2024 Building Permits, with a total of five ERUs indicated on the list. Secretary Greg Kuntz made a **motion** to approve the lists as presented with five total ERUs from the Building Permits. Chairman Roger Messmer seconded the motion. **Motion** Passed 2-0.

IDEM Monthly Report: Stormwater Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that the monthly IDEM report has been completed and filed. The report listed 11 open sites that were inspected. There were no rain events over ½" of rain and a total of 1.53" of rain for the month of March.

Site updates: Stormwater Coordinator Chad Mundy updated the Board on several construction sites in the city. He noted progress on each site.

Erosion Control Permits: Stormwater Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that there was no new plans received since the last Stormwater Board meeting. There have been no new permits since the last Stormwater Board meeting.

Illicit Discharge & Spills: Stormwater Coordinator Chad Mundy updated the Board on Yamato's Restaurant. Chad touched base with Yamato's to make sure the vent was clean and will keep up on the issue until finished. No other spills or discharges to report.

IDEM Update: Stormwater Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that the IDEM Annual Report is completed, sent in and verified that it was received.

Training & Conference 2024: Stormwater Coordinator Chad Mundy stated that he attended a conference in Chandler, Indiana hosted by Karen Barnhill. The training was wonderful, lots of partners attended and hours were logged. Other upcoming events are Earth Day at Memorial Hospital, the annual Strassenfest planning meeting and educational programs for Jasper Middle School Science Class.

Mayor Dean Vonderheide spoke at the end of the meeting to the Board regarding future planning and research for stormwater strategies and how to implement water runoff due to Jasper's residential growth.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a **Motion** was made by Secretary Greg Kuntz, seconded by Chairman Roger Messmer. **Motion** carried 2-0, and the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 a.m.
