# Acknowledgement of April 15 DLFG TIF MGMT Report

Clerk Treasurer Kiersten Knies distributed and reviewed the Department of Local Government and Finance TIF Management Report. Ms. Knies reported that the base value of the TIF's remain with the City of Jasper. The TIF's include Central Allocation Area, Riverfront

Allocation Area, University Heights Allocation Area, and recently established Northridge Estates Residential Housing Allocation Area.

After further discussion, John Kahle made a motion to acknowledge the Redevelopment Commission's receipt of the report. Laura Grammer seconded it. Motion carried 5-0.

#### PROGRESS REPORT OF JASPER OUTDOOR POOL

City of Jasper Park and Rec Director, Tom Moorman, shared construction progress photos of the new Jasper city pool. Mr. Moorman reported that the trees have been removed along the property line between St. Thomas Medical Center and the pool property, and the sloping is complete. Rip Rap has been added to the northern section. Mr. Moorman also noted that the pouring of the pool desk is in progress as well as the diving platform construction. The pool should be filled by May 1<sup>st</sup> and construction remains on schedule.
