The selected individual will work with a wide variety of responsibilities including, but not limited to install, maintain, and repair line poles and prefabricated light-duty metal structures, cable and related equipment to construct distribution power lines used to conduct electrical energy between generating stations, substations, and consumers. Operate various heavy equipment, heavy duty trucks, forklifts, bucket trucks and backhoes. Climbs poles or rides in bucket and installs equipment, such as transformers, lightning arrestors, and auxiliary equipment. Investigates low voltage complaints and power outages. Works outdoors in all weather conditions. Understanding all circuits used on the system and the related safety requirements. Participate in scheduled on-call time. High School diploma or general education degree (GED). Preferably three months to one year related electrical work experience and equipment operation. Required to pass and maintain a valid Indiana Commercial Driver's License (CDL) "Class B" minimum. Required to successfully complete Lineman Apprenticeship Program Certification.
