The Regular Meeting of the Jasper City Park and Recreation Board was called to order at 4:30 P. M. by President Seger.

Member Ruhe led the board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the regular November meeting were approved on a motion by Secretary Otto and seconded by Member Eckerle. All were in favor 4-0.

The monthly claims were approved on a motion by Secretary Otto and seconded by Member Ruhe. All were in favor 4-0.

Jeb Stratton presented the board with his Eagle Scout presentation. He would like to install baskets and tee pads at the Ruxer Disc Golf Course to shorten the distance of the holes. This would shorten the course for newer or younger players. Secretary Otto made a motion to approve the project. Member Ruhe seconded. All were in favor 4-0.

OAC Director Dick gave the Older Americans Report. Exercise classes continue to do well. The December bus trip will be to the Derby Diner to see Elf.

Dick requested permission to hire a new OAC custodian. Secretary Otto made a motion to approve the hiring. Member Eckerle seconded. All were in favor 4-0.

Community Engagement Coordinator Reckelhoff gave the tourism report. Letters to Santa at the Schoolhouse were well attended. Approximately 201 people attended the cookie decorating with Mrs. Claus.

Pro shop manager Kurt Uebelhor gave the golf report. Buffalo Trace took in \$19,053.63 at the Pro Shop in November. The Driving Range took in \$1,872.00 For a grand total of \$20,925.63 for the month of November.

Uebelhor presented the board with a list of fertilizers for the golf course (attached to the minutes.) Member Ruhe made a motion to accept the quotes. Member Eckerle seconded. All were in favor 4-0.


Assistant Director Gutgsell presented bridge quote update. He recommended that the bridges approaches as well as alternates 1 and 2 be accepted from the low quote from Custom Creations. After discussion Secretary Otto made a motion to accept the recommendations for a total of \$81,026.00. Member Eckerle seconded. All were in favor 4-0.

Director Moorman gave a parks update. Winterizing of all locations is ongoing. The mill wheel was repaired. Moorman stated that the list of pool purchases will be presented to the RDA at the December meeting, to be approved to pay from the bond.

Moorman requested to change the title of Pool Concessions to Pool Services. This will encompass concessions, deck crew and slide attendants. Member Ruhe made a motion to recommend the change to the common council for approval. Secretary Otto seconded. All were in favor 4-0.

Director Moorman gave the rentable facilities reports.

Being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 4:52 P.M. on a motion by Secretary Otto. Member Ruhe seconded. All were in favor 4-0.
