More than a concert, 6 *Guitars* is a pitch perfect blend of music, comedy, and characters. Just 1 performer portrays 6 unique guitar players, each representing their own style of music. Blues, Jazz, Rock, Classical, Folk, and Country are all featured.

As each character shares the anecdotes and songs that define their relationship to music, the audience is treated to breathtaking musicianship, beautiful storytelling, and top notch comedy. There are even audience interactive bits that tailor each performance to any given crowd.

Chase Padgett, who co-wrote and performs the show, graduated from the University of Central Florida with a Bachelor of Arts in Music in 2007 and has been a full time actor and musician ever since. Chase also received instruction in improv from the world famous iO training center in Chicago and provided various roles at Walt Disney World, Universal Studios, and the SAK Theatre in Orlando, FL as an actor, improviser and musician until 2010 when his solo career demanded his focus full time. In 2014 he performed in a comedy showcase for NBC and since then has performed with Wayne Brady and Colin Mocherie from 'Whose Line Is It Anyway.'

Since it premiered in 2010, *6 Guitars* has been performed to roaring standing ovations. The show's unique, but universal, message connects with any musician or music lover regardless of one's age, background, or favorite genre. This show truly has something for everyone.
