Two distinct shows are set to hit the Jasper Arts Center stage as Tonic Sol-fa and The Shaun Johnson Big Band Experience team up for one incredible night of music.

Tonic Sol-fa is a ground-breaking a cappella ensemble from Minnesota, in constant development since their formation two decades ago. Tonic Sol-fa stand as one of the leading forces in the world of vocal music with Emmy award-winning arrangements and multi-million selling compositions.
