The group defines ART CLOTH as cloth TRANSFORMED by adding or subtracting color, line, shape, texture, value, or fiber to CREATE a compelling surface. Each member brings a personal vision and sensibility to his or her cloth. The group was formed to provide a support forum as well as exhibition opportunities for its members and to promote an appreciation of art cloth in the broader community.

Art Cloth Network meets annually in a different city where they conduct business, but the highlight is always days of viewing each others' artwork. There are regional get togethers and special interest pods, as well. The group puts on frequent exhibits at museums and galleries throughout North America.
