

What to Expect When Returning to the Older Americans Center

1. Limited programming will begin on a limited basis, as noted on the calendar. Most programs will remain on hold at this time based on considerations of current guidelines by ISDH, CDC, Dubois County Health Department and local government guidelines.
2. We will return to a reduced in-person exercise class schedule, but pre-registration is necessary. Please know that extra precautions will be required and need to be followed upon returning.
3. Before entering the Older Americans Center, please contact your healthcare provider if you are considered high risk and/or 65+.
4. Masks are mandatory upon entering the building and during your entire visit. This is for the safety of others and yourself.
5. Please utilize the banquet room entry door to enter the building. Upon entering the building, you MUST:
 - Take your temperature using the temperature scanner.
 - Sanitize your hands.
 - Sign-in, record your temperature and complete the self-screen questions listed on the posted liability waiver.
6. If returning books or puzzles, please return them in the designated area so that they can be isolated and disinfected before returning to the shelf.
7. We suggest that you bring your own water bottle and avoid using the water fountains.
8. Promote and adhere to social distancing of 6 feet. We request no personal contact, including handshaking, hugging or other physical contact.
9. Chairs and tables will be arranged to allow for social distancing. We kindly request you do not move or rearrange them.
10. Please wash and sanitize your hands often.
11. There are extra cleaning and sanitizing protocols of the building that have been implemented.
12. If there is a confirmed COVID-19 case, the Older Americans Center may be required/ requested to close for a period of time.
13. All events and Center hours are subject to change. You can stay informed via WBDC, WITZ, The Herald, and Facebook.
14. If you are not feeling well—please STAY home.
